Descriptions of Graduate Assistantships

Job Description: Competitive graduate teaching assistantships are available for research and teaching undergraduate courses in swimming, jogging, aerobics, Pilates, First Aid, Health, Fitness for Life classes, and exercise physiology labs. Two other NCAA Division 1 assistantships are available in strength and conditioning and athletic training.

Graduate assistantships can only be offered to students officially admitted into the program. Therefore, students are encouraged to apply early for full consideration.

Compensation: One hundred percent tuition remission (not including student fees) and stipend (~\$11,250+ per year). All GA stipends are approximate and contingent upon funding.

How to Apply: Send the following electronically to the FAU Graduate Coordinator: resume, list of three references (minimum) with complete contact information, letter of application, and the form at:
